

2023 Hawai'i Women's Coalition Legislative Package

Measure Description
Extend protections for healthcare professionals who are providing healthcare related to abortion.
Amend civil Statute of Limitation for child sexual abuse to allow for longer period of time (50 years) to file civil lawsuit against abusers.
Mandatory Domestic Violence Training for Custody Evaluators and Fact Finders (brought back from 2022 session).
Provide free period products in universities and community colleges.
Provide free period products in government buildings.
Housekeeping and strengthening abortion statutes re: viability etc.
Amend HRS 844G to prohibit entering victim's DNA profile collected in a Sex Assault Kit into any offender database for purposes of offender identification.
Waiver for Mediation in Paternity Cases for Survivors of Domestic Violence (brought back from 2022 session).
Comprehensive insurance coverage (audit similar to SCR62 from 2022 Legislative Session).
Erin's Law: Mandating Sexual abuse curriculum in public schools. Curriculum for K-12, educators and parents.
Amend Licensed Midwife law to provide full scope practice to Certified Midwives.
Creating and funding an Abortion Access Coordinator Office within UH JABSOM.
Relating to Child Support —TANF (2021 Carry over, HB 734).
Joint Resolution to study Relating to Female Genital Mutilation & Relating to Marriage of Minors.
